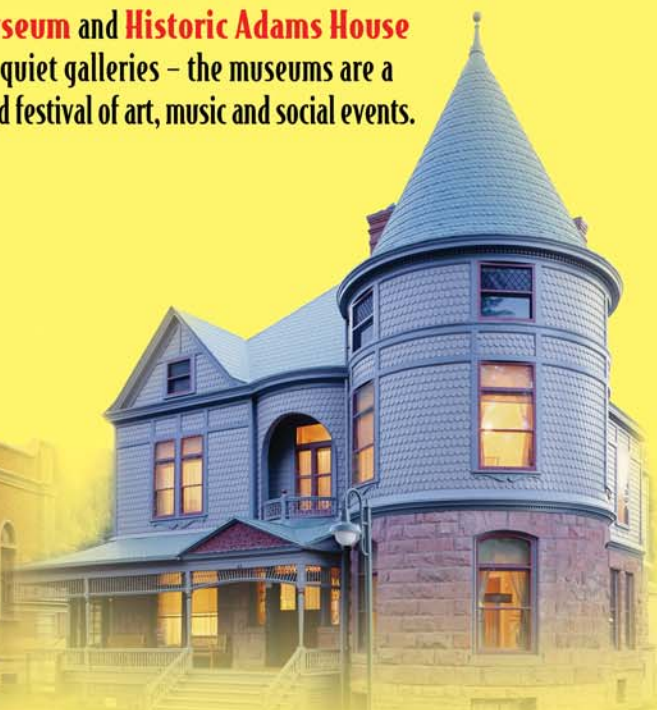


THE LEGENDS OF DEADWOOD



THE ADAMS

The **Adams Museum** and **Historic Adams House** offer more than quiet galleries – the museums are a lively, year-round festival of art, music and social events.



Three floors of captivating exhibits explore the geological, natural and cultural history of Deadwood and the Black Hills: Now featuring the *Digging Deadwood: Understanding Chinatown* exhibition, as well as select items from the City of Deadwood's Wild Bill Hickok Collection, including Wild Bill's gun. View a one-of-a-kind plesiosaur, Potato Creek Johnny's gold nugget, a vast collection of historic photographs and maps and a delightful assortment of regional folk art. Visit the Adams Bros. Bookstore, hailed the best in the Black Hills. The museum welcomes 80,000 visitors each year.

The Historic Adams House is a fully restored Queen-Anne style Victorian mansion – a virtual time capsule of Deadwood's turn-of-the-century upper class. The home is filled with original artifacts – from monogrammed silver and lavish furnishings to family photos and personal correspondence – that chronicle Deadwood's transition from a rough and tumble mining camp to a stable center of industry and commerce. Over 15,000 guests tour the home each year.
